Currently Headteacher for ISG Jubail, Mr. Wootton possesses a thorough working knowledge of the National Curriculum of England.

With over 23 years experience in educational leadership, and as a teacher and highly-skilled musician, Mr. Wootton offers a unique blend of technical knowledge, professional experience and creativity to lead the development of Sara Village School.

Sara Village School will open its doors officially in August 2010, becoming ISG's seventh multi-cultural school within the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. Situated on BAE's purpose-built compound, the new campus will have an enrollment capacity estimated at 160 students, serving Foundation Stage through Year 6.

Mr. Wootton began his ISG career in 1987 with Jubail British School teaching Music and Physical Education. In 1993, he became Deputy Headteacher on a part-time basis. He was appointed British Headteacher in the year 2000 and Site Administrator of ISG Jubail School in 2004 when the American and British Schools were combined into one.

Mr. Wootton holds a Bachelors of Education [Honors] from Worcester University. This spring he will complete the International Leadership and Management Program, a professional qualification program sponsored by the National Association of Headteachers (NAHT), ECIS and managed by Fieldwork Education Consultants.

Mr. Wootton's long history in Saudi Arabia, profound understanding of the ISG community and geographical proximity are key assets. In the coming months, he will work closely with parents, staff and community leaders to coordinate planning efforts for the new campus. Joining him on the move will be his wife and ISG Jubail Information Technology teacher, Sandra Wootton. Mr. and Mrs. Wootton have three adult daughters who have grown up within the ISG educational network.
