## A message from the School Liaison Officer

Dear All

Since I issued the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sara Village School Newsletter in March it has come to my attention that some of you are still unsure about the school uniform policy.

I have spoken with Mr Mark Wootton again and below is outlined what it is to consist of.

### GIRLS

A pale blue polo shirt. Black skirt. Black Shorts or black trousers.

Girls may also wear a gingham pale blue and white check dress. A black pinafore may also be worn with the pale blue polo shirt worn underneath. The lengths of the shorts, skirt, or dress are to be appropriately knee level.

### BOYS

A pale blue polo shirt. Black trousers or black shorts.

### FOOTWEAR

A pair of smart black shoes or suitable trainers. Students are not allowed to wear flip flops, sandals or crocs to school.

There is no Sara Village School logo at present. One will be designed by the students once the school is operational in August. Polo shirts with BISA or DBGS logos may not be worn.

### PE KIT

A white round necked, capped sleeved t-shirt and black shorts. A PE kit will be chosen and sourced by Mr Wootton and made available for purchase through the school later in the year. Trainers only may be worn for sports lessons.

With regard to the wearing of jewellery please see the ISG student / parent handbook and follow their policies on what is acceptable jewellery wear.
